We suggest that you start the eco-island design in class and then send it home for homework. It might be easiest to collect in all your class's entry forms and send them to us at the National Schools Partnership together. Alternatively, parents can choose to send the entry in to us directly.

Remember, the entries will be judged on how eco-friendly the island is following the themes of the activity sheets.
