Bumbling Inspector Clouseau solves his cases by accident. But real crimes are solved using brilliant brainwork, so brush up on these essential detective skills!



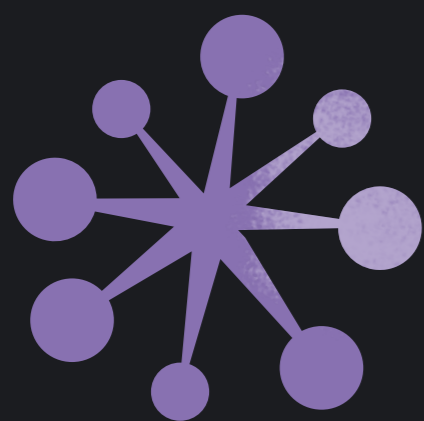
GATHERING CLUES
